 **NEW LIFE IN CHRIST...** Congratulations to **Crew Henry Katsetos** and to his parents. Last Saturday, he received Christ's new life through Baptism by water and the Holy Spirit. We all at Holy Spirit Parish pledge our support to him and his parents so that he will grow steadily and fully in his new life.

 **The 2025 DPAA is right around the corner. This year our goal is \$44,000.** ALL monies pledged and collected over our goal will be returned to our Parish free of Diocesan taxes! This year, we will use 100% of the rebate monies for **new hardscaping and landscaping in the front of our beautiful church.**

The landscape design firm, **Brentwood Landscape and Design**, has been selected for this project. The overall design includes installing limestone walls along the Washington Avenue public sidewalks (like the neighboring properties and keeping in line with the historical guidelines of Newport) and installing new trees, shrubs, and other plantings. **The walls will serve several purposes:** 1) solve the erosion problems; 2) make mowing the lawn easier for our volunteers...to name a few reasons.

The **total cost** of the project is **\$142k**. A portion of this project, **\$50K**, will be paid for from the bequest of Jan Meiner; only **\$92k remains!**

A table is set up in the main vestibule with the design, images of the type of wall and stone, and possible plantings. Be sure to check it out!
