ITEM OF THE WEEK: Large, heavy-duty, black trash bags for the cold shelter (more info next column)

Our Parish has partnered with the Emergency Shelter of Northern Kentucky in Covington, St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Newport, and Campbell County Fiscal Court to operate an emergency cold shelter for the 24/25 Winter season.

The shelter will be housed at St. Paul's Church on Court Street (near the Campbell County Court House), managed by the Emergency Shelter of NKY, and funded through the Campbell County Fiscal Court.
